COMPOSITION: 50% Syrah,
35% Grenache, 15% Mourvèdre

TASTING NOTES:

The aromatics of our Three Sisters Cuvée are driven by strawberry and toffee with background subtleties of bacon fat, black pepper and floral notes. Upfront, the flavor profile begins with cherry, strawberry, vanilla, and candy-esque flavors supported by refreshing front-end acidity. The mid-palate is driven by fine grain tannin transitioning to a lengthy finish dominated by toffee and dried red fruits.
