2017 LONE TREE CABERNET FRANC

Tasting Notes:

Simply put, our 2017 Cabernet Franc is amazing. The freshly opened wine manages to impress but evolves into something magnificent with gentle aeration. Upon pulling the cork, the nose is skewed towards the savory, with hints of olive tapenade and dried sage. These notes darken and evoke to slightly sweetened malty chocolate. The palate is consistent, with finely grained tannin supporting flavors of coffee, cassis and blackberry. This is a wine of great length and stature. Those who lay down a few bottles will be justly rewarded over time.
