2018 GSM RESERVE

Tasting Notes:

Juicy, ripe and delicious, is a brief description of our 2018 Reserve GSM. This wine is a beautiful, dark garnet color in the glass. Spicy aromas of dark stone fruits intermingle with those of sweet boysenberry and medium "plus" toasted oak. On the palate, the flavors are decadently rich and present themselves upon a finely textured tannin structure. The acidity stands firm in the face of opulence and serves as a balanced counterpoint. While this wine will only mellow and age well over the next 5 to 7 years, it is drinking remarkedly in its youth.
