Tasting Notes:

Showing a bright, crimson hue in the glass, the nose offers juicy aromas of raspberry, dark stone fruits, and hints of vanilla. The flavors on the palate are amazingly concentrated yet soft and approachable. Syrah serves as a silky base while the Grenache brings beautiful, limestone influenced texture and Mourvèdre adds some racy spice notes. The versatility means you can enjoy this wine as an aperitif or served alongside a wide range of fare.
