2018 CHILENO TEMPRANILLO

Tasting Notes:

Our 2018 Tempranillo has hallmarks of a youthful wine with lively fruit character on the palate and a backbone of refreshing acidity. At the same time, this wine shows the sort of soft balance that typically comes from cellar aging. We have never labeled a wine as an old soul before, but there is a first time for everything. The nose exhibits flowery notes intermingled with zesty fruit and hints of wet clay. On the palate, the lively fruit is presented on a soft and supple mid-palate. This versatile wine will pair especially well with preparations of pork or venison.
