2018 PANCHO PETIT VERDOT

Tasting Notes:

Our 2018 Pancho Petit Verdot is a decadent, age-worthy wine. Rising from the deep-purple hue in the glass are aromas of concentrated blackberry and coffee with hints of medium toasted oak. The wine is supple and luxurious yet remains incredibly balanced thanks to the counterweight tannin and acid profiles. The addition of Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec bring needed finesse and depth to the composition. Juicy, ripe flavors are framed in by bright aromatics on the entry to the palate and finely textured minerality that carries the wine to a graceful finish.
