2019 THE PERGOLA PETITE SIRAH

Tasting Notes:

Behind this inky veil, is a wine full of juicy, fruit-laden personality. We employ a long, slow fermentation by keeping the temperature low. This allows for a gentle extraction of tannin while keeping the bright, fruit character intact. 10% of this blend was aged in new American Oak barrels resulting in a hint of vanilla that plays beautifully with the flavors on the mid-palate. This is a great bottle to open for pairing with a main course of grilled steak. Afterwards, should you have some left in the bottle, it'll be a versatile companion for cobbler with vanilla ice cream.
