## 2019 Lone Tree Cabernet Franc

### Tasting Notes:

Upon first opening the nose is somewhat reclusive, offering savory notes of graphite alongside hints of chocolate. As the wine aerates and the bouquet opens, aromas of baking spice, white pepper and violets become plentiful. The mouthfeel is full-bodied and lush with ample acidity to frame in the presentation. This vintage has the manners to be enjoyed with lighter fare but will shine its brightest alongside a grilled ribeye. A powerful, yet elegant, wine that will evolve beautiful over the next decade.
