Tasting Notes:

The 2013 vintage of The Point is a unique, powerful, and ripe expression of Bordeaux varieties. The vibrant aromatics are driven by black current and raspberry, with beautiful subtleties of leather and bramble. Immediately refreshing front-end acidity attacks the palate and continues through the mid-palate with blackberry and cassis. This transitions to a lengthy finish with soft but supportive tannic structure.
