2016 THREE SISTERS CUVÉE

Tasting Notes:

This wine's components seamlessly blend together, making for a delightful and exuberant experience. In the glass, the wine displays a deep and rich garnet, proclaiming its freshness and spritely acidity. Plum and star anise yield to black licorice and leather as the wine blossoms on the nose. The bright fruit aromatics are buoyed by a full and enveloping mouth feel. On the palate, this wine exhibits ripe pomegranate and hints of clove. Pleasingly fine tannins offer length and a delicate finish and to this well-balanced wine.
