2016 *LONE TREE* CABERNET FRANC

Tasting Notes:

Our 2016 *Lone Tree* Cabernet Franc shows a beautiful, dense garnet color in the glass. Aromatically, this wine offers a bouquet of creamy black currant and clean clay soil with a hint of cinnamon spice.

Very finely grained with chalky tannin, it is framed in by lovely acidity. Flinty mineral notes accompany those of chocolate and black cherry.

The supple richness of the mid-palate carries on for some time in a well-composed, graceful manner.
