APPELLATION: Paso Robles, California

COMPOSITION: 50% Grenache, 35% Syrah, 15% Mourvèdre

TASTING NOTES:

The aromatics of our *Three Sisters Cuvée* are driven by strawberry and toffee with background subtleties of bacon fat, black pepper and floral notes. Upfront, the flavor profile begins with cherry, strawberry, vanilla, and candy-esque flavors supported by refreshing front-end acidity. The mid-palate is driven by fine grain tannin transitioning to a lengthy finish dominated by toffee and dried red fruits.
