TASTING NOTES:

Petite Sirah is one of the most powerful varieties grown in the entire Paso Robles AVA. *The Pergola* is testimony in the glass, with dark purple and blackish hues. Our 2011 Petite Sirah releases seductive blueberry, coffee, blackberry and dried violet aromas with each swirl in the glass. The flavor profile is driven with black fruit and blueberry, wrapped up in a raspberry, clove and fine grained tannic finish.
