COMPOSITION: 81% Malbec, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 9% Petit Verdot

TASTING NOTES:

Aromatically, *Babicora* is layered with rich black fruits laden with tropical notes such as passion fruit and lychee nut. *Babicora* is stylistically similar to Argentinian Malbecs, with a flavor profile driven by front end blackberry jam flavors. The mid-palate is dominated by game and cherry flavors that transition to a raspberry and French oak tannin driven finish that is reminiscent of sweet cassis.
